

God is the Creator

(The Holy Spirit is the Creator)

"The Spirit of God has made me, and the breath of the Almighty gives me life." (Job 33:4) "The earth was without form, and void; and darkness was on the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters."

(Genesis 1:1-2)

What are some examples in the Bible that tell us that God knows everything?

"Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him." (Coronations 2:9-10)

"As they ministered to the Lord and fasted, the Holy Spirit said, "Now separate to Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." Then, having fasted and prayed, and laid hands on them, they sent them away." (Acts 13:2-3).

God is Omnipresent

"Where can I go from Your Spirit? Or where can I flee from Your presence? If I ascend into heaven, You are there; if I make my bed in hell, behold, You are there. If I take the wings of the morning, and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea." (Psalm 139:7-9).

"But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you."
(Romans 8:11).

God is the One who raises People from the Dead

God is the only One who Knows the Future

"For prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit." (2 Peter 1:21).

"Now when they bring you to the synagogues and magistrates and authorities, do not worry about how or what you should answer, or what you should say. For the Holy Spirit will teach you in that very hour what you ought to say." (Luke 12:11-12).

"And they were not able to resist the wisdom and the Spirit by which he spoke." (Acts 6:10).

Regarding the eternity of the Holy Spirit, the Lord Jesus said:

"And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper that He may abide with you forever." (John 14:16).
