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Sunday School

What is sunday school?

- Sunday school is the Teaching arm of the church

(If it wasn't learned by the student, it wasn't taught by the teacher)

- Sunday school is the Reaching arm of the church
- Sunday school is the Discipleship arm of the church

(John 8:31-32)

Win the challenges

For in that He Himself has suffered, being tempted, He is able to aid those who are tempted.
(Hebrews 2:18)

5. Preparation

How to prepare a lesson?

- ● Identify the central theme of the lesson
- ● Give yourself time to prepare the lesson
- ● Do not attempt to cram it all in one setting, last minute

5. Preparation

You cannot lead your class until you know where you are going!

- Find structure for your lesson
- Prepare a lesson outline
- Use some visual aids to teach
- Build on what the kids may already know
