Role of the Presenters (Youth)

Before the Meeting:

This is how you will use the three weeks you are preparing to present:

- At the end of the first week send your draft presentation to your mentor, you will receive feedback and suggestions for improvement
- By Wednesday of the second week provide your final presentation with the suggested changes to your mentor

PowerPoint Presentation Suggestions:

- Font >18
- Short sentences for each bullet point; avoid stacked text
- Provide an outline of the lesson upfront
- You can use the (Notes) section for the necessary text for the presenter's use
- Pictures are encouraged
- Avoid animations; they distract the audience
- Aim for 10 to 15 slides
